Our founders message

Dear Friends in Christ,

I am writing this letter to you to express my deep appreciation for your kindness and support of our mission work in Colombia known as Shepherds of the Meek. With the Holy Spirit's intercession, our ministry has grown tremendously in just over one year through membership, sponsors and donors.

Praise and thanks be to God for working in such amazing ways. Our fact finding mission to Colombia took place in October 2012. I led our group of six members to the mother house of Servants of Christ Priest in Bogota. We met with Mother Superior and the financial director who were our wonderful hosts during our week long stay. The next few days were spent touring several satellite orphanages surrounding Bogota including Girardot. After discussing at length with the sisters the decision to assist Girardot, where the most need was evident, became our goal.

Our first project as a mission was serving Lenten dinners resulting with the KOC generously giving us our initial seed money for future fundraisers. Our Rodeo followed in April with the generous support of both the Hispanic and Anglo communities netting over \$10,000 in proceeds. Our second fundraiser was held October 4 at Our Lady of Victory School in Tyrone. Thanks to our wonderful sponsors, volunteers, donors and patrons our art auction fundraiser netted \$18,000.

Our second trip to Bogota and Girardot confirmed the progress of the renovations on the chapel. Amazing work was completed including mold and mildew repair, stucco, painting, tile repair and replacement with intricate statue and crucifix restoration. Our observation concluded that additional funds were needed to complete the renovations. This would conclude our project.

During our stay we had the pleasure of participating in a several day celebration honoring the founding of the orphanage 95 years ago by Sr Margaurite. All eight satellite orphanages participated in dance, music, and plays.

Finally, without supporters such as you, Shepherds of the meek mission work is impossible. Therefore, we are forever grateful for your support. I hope that you will continue to be blessed and guided by the Holy Spirit so that you can continue to support mission work such as ours.





